## JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Develop and maintain positive relations with homeless consumers, clients, staff and local authorities.
- 2. Maintain a written journal (log); documenting routine inspections and times, activities, property conditions and infractions of policy.
- 3. Respond to calls for assistance.
- 4. Report any unsafe, unsanitary or unusual situations in writing.
- 5. Become knowledgeable of proper radio procedures, and respond accordingly.
- 6. Maintain a current log of persons trespassed from the property and enforce trespassing policy
- 7. Deter criminal mischief by maintaining a visible presence
- 8. Manage traffic flow.
- 9. Patrol property, including Owens Avenue ramps, parking areas and driveways to ensure transient homeless and clients are not in restricted areas or sites prohibited by program policies.
- 10. Record and file accident and injury reports with program administrators.
